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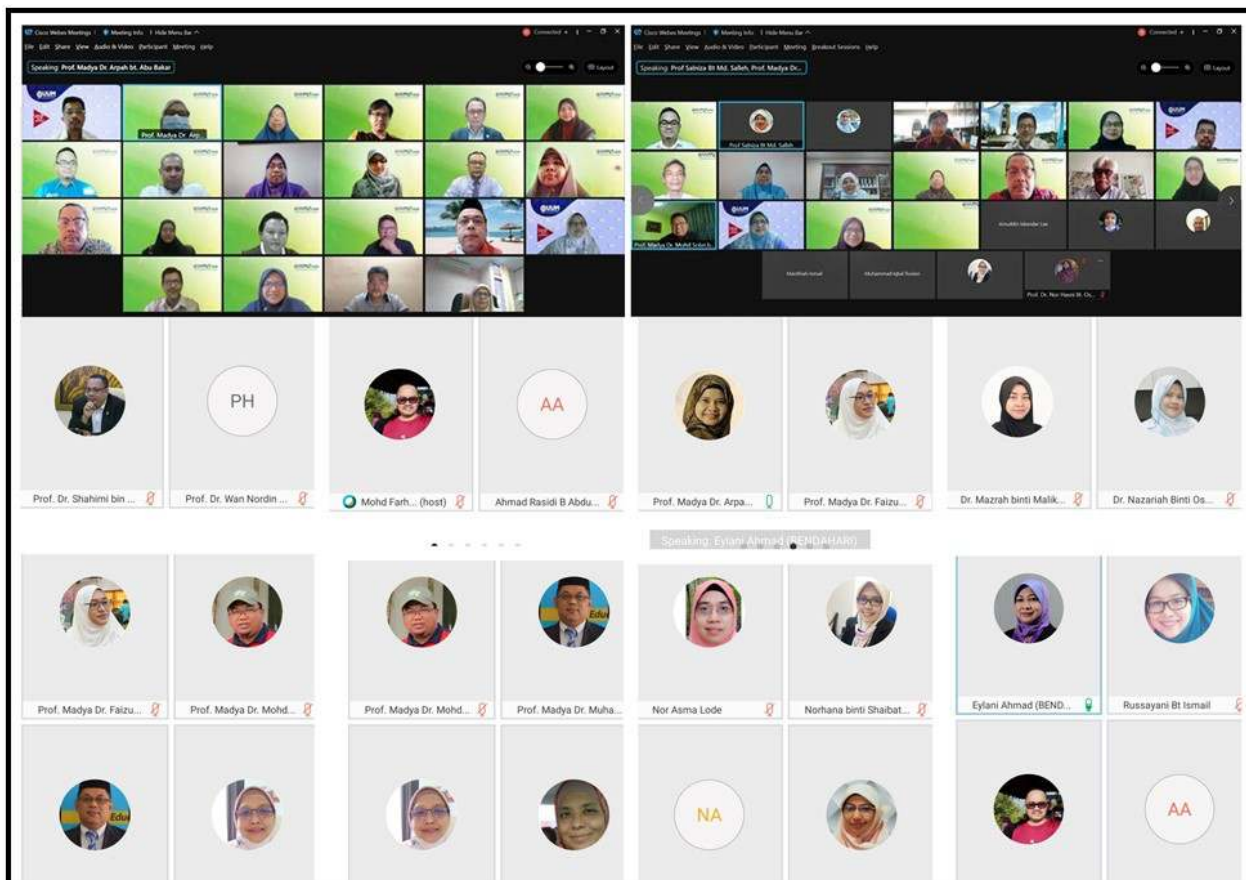

UUM ONLINE: In preparation for receiving the AACSB International virtual audit visit in July and October, the AACSB Accreditation Unit held a two -day Continuous Improvement Review (CIR) Reporting Workshop on June 29 via Webex.
