Introduction:

LyX is an advanced open source document processor running on Linux/Unix, Windows, and Mac OS X. It called a "document processors", because unlike standard word processors, LyX encourages an approach to writing based on the structure of users' document, not their appearance. LyX lets users concentrate on writing, leaving details of visual layout to the software. LyX automates formatting according to predefined rule sets, yielding consistency throughout even the most complex documents. LyX produces high quality and professional documents.
