HEP ONLINE: Seramai 30 orang staf Bahagian Pentadbiran dan Kewangan, Pusat Alumni serta Unit Penerbitan, Media dan Penyelidikan Jabatan Hal Ehwal Pelajar (HEP), UUM telah menyertai aktiviti berjalan 10,000 langkah baru-baru ini.
