



UUM's Ahmad Fawzi ^{ST 24/5/05} dies at 56 ^{8:6}

ALOR STAR: Universiti Utara Malaysia vice-chancellor Prof Datuk Dr Ahmad Fawzi Mohd Basri (picture) died at the Selayang Hospital at 4.47pm yesterday.

A university spokesman said Dr Ahmad Fawzi, 56, who is the National Service Training Council chairman, died from blood poisoning.

Dr Ahmad Fawzi was admitted to the Kedah Medical Centre following a stroke on Jan 5 and was moved to the Selayang Hospital on Jan 26.

He was appointed UUM vice-chancellor on Oct 2, 2001.

He leaves behind wife Aishah Ibrahim and four children.
