Duli Yang Teramat Mulia Tengku Sarafudin remarked that, respect is earned only when an individual demonstrates sincere integrity.

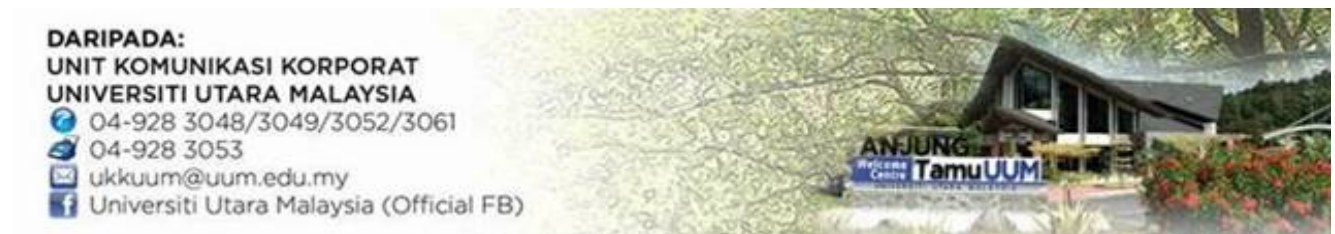
"I would like to share a popular quote in English:
