



UUM ONLINE: Vice-Chancellor of Universiti Utara Malaysia (UUM) Prof. Dato' Dr Ahmad Bashawir Abdul Ghani, thanked all frontline personnel who assisted in the management of the COVID-19 Quarantine Centre at the SME Bank Bukit Kachi Sintok Student Residential Hall from 13 to 26 June 2021.

He stated that the Residential Hall staff handled the students' entry and exit records and data, while officers from the Royal Malaysian Police (RMP), Civil Defence Force (CDF), Ministry of Health Malaysia (MoH) District of Kubang Pasu, UUM Health Centre, UUM Security Department, and departments under the auspices of the Student Affairs Department handled other tasks.

"The commitment of all staff who were involved in food distribution, sanitation, health screening including swab screening during the Enhanced Movement Control Order (PKPD) is greatly appreciated by the management of UUM and the Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE)," he said in a statement issued.

He stated that during the time students were quarantined, they were not only provided with food and beverages, but also with supplies of dry goods and other necessities via the foodbank until the quarantine centre was closed.

The EMCO that was enforced at the UUM campus in Sintok Kedah from 13 to 26 June 2021, was lifted after the government was satisfied with the well-managed prevention and control measures put in place by UUM and the agencies involved.
