

According to the Project Director, Mohd Hafizi Ahmad, they plan to break the current record as stated in the Malaysia Book of Records, which stands at a circumference of 19.8 meters and a width of 12 meters.

Mohd Hafizi added that more than 2,000 students will be involved in constructing the logo which will require as many as 670,000 pieces of 10 sen coins.

The Deputy Vice-Chancellor of Student and Alumni Affairs, UUM, Datuk Dr. Ahmad Faiz Hamid, is expected to place the first coin on 1 October, while the Deputy Minister of Information II, Ministry of Information, Communication, and Culture, Senator Datuk Maglin Dennis D`Cruz, is expected to place the last coin on the logo on 3 October.

Mohd Hafizi said that the total sum of money, from the collected coins, would later be channeled to various charities as well as the ECOSA fund.

"We hope that all parties, mainly UUM students and staff members, will extend their full support in helping us realize this project, which will not only make history, but also contribute monetarily to those in need," he added.
