Dr Karim is a strong advocate of leveraging the Internet as an alternative medium for learning and teaching. He has developed and maintained several teaching portals, websites, online courses and blogs related to teaching/learning and research. As of May 7, 2021, his 392 teaching videos on YouTube Channel have received 964+ thousand views from 190+ countries, with an estimated hour watched of 69K and a total of 5700+ subscribers.
