DAY 1: INTRODUCTION TO BASIC AND ADVANCED SPSS



The first segment titled as “Introduction to Basic and Advanced SPSS” out of the Inasis Proton Workshop series was held yesterday, and the workshop commenced at BME of Inasis Proton at 6.00 PM. Out of the total five workshops, “Introduction to Basic and Advanced SPSS, was the first workshop that was organized by Inasis Proton Postgraduate Scholars, and the total participants of the first workshop were 25.

Around 7.00 PM, there was a break for Magrib prayer, accompanied by tea and evening snacks. After 20 minutes of break, the session resumed and continued till 10.00 PM. The dinner was provided to the participants after 10.05 PM, and after 15 minutes break for dinner, the session restarted with a short speech, delivered by our Principal of DPP dormitory, Dr. Ghozali Hassan.
