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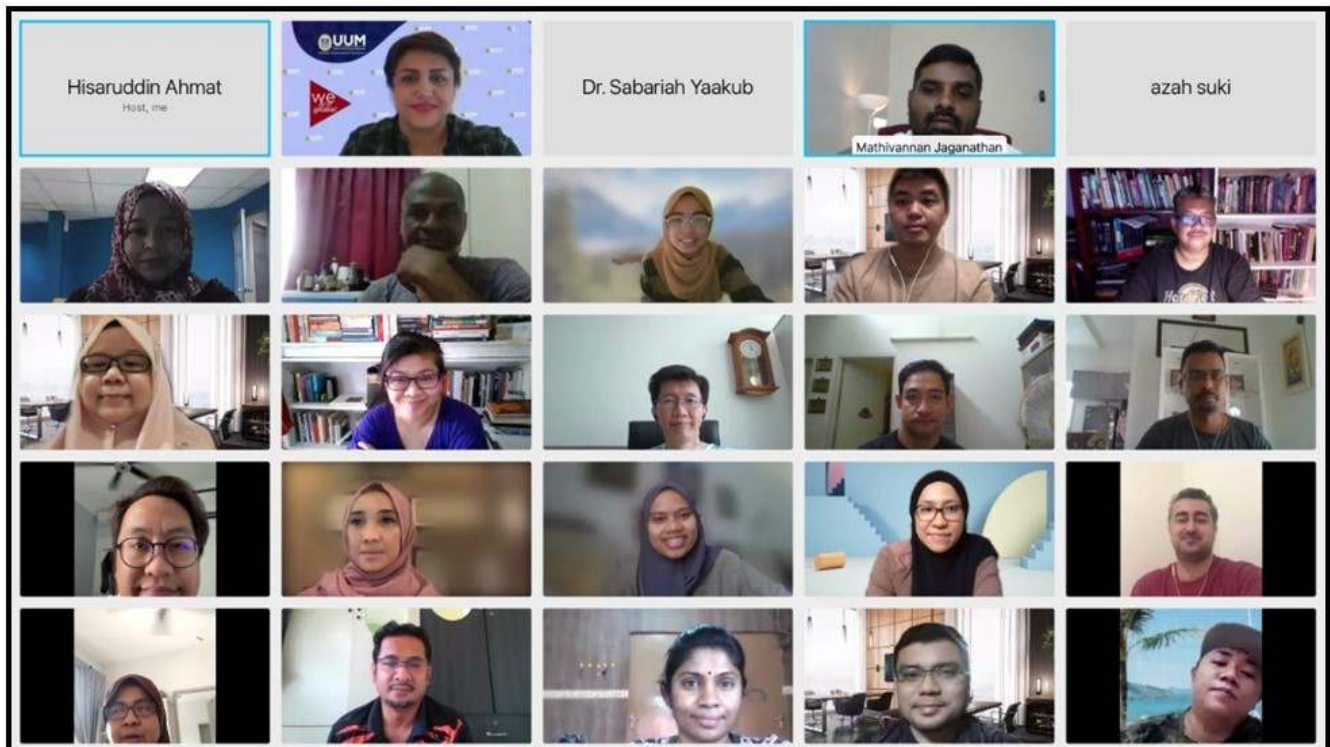

OYAGSB DOCTORAL TRAINING 'MENDELEY: AN ESSENTIAL TOOL FOR A RESEARCHER'



UUM ONLINE: Othman Yeop Abdullah Graduate School of Business (OYAGSB) recently held a Doctoral Training. More than 150 participants attended the two-hour training session on Mendeley Reference which was conducted by Ts. Dr Mathivannan Jaganathan from the School of Business Management, College of Business (COB).

According to the Director of PhD and D. Management Programme at OYAGSB, Dr Sahar E-Vahdati, the event was aimed at enhancing postgraduate students' high-level research abilities.

During the session, participants were enlightened on the use of Mendeley, a free reference manager that can assist researchers and scholars in collecting references, organising citations, and creating bibliographies. Mendeley also serves as an academic social network, allowing scholars to share their research with others. Researchers can collaborate online in public or private groups, and search the Mendeley group database of over 30 million papers for papers.

Mendeley can assist researchers in connecting with other scholars and discovering the most recent and relevant research in their field. Researchers can also use their Mendeley profile to establish a professional presence. Mendeley is now integrated with ScienceDirect because it is now owned by Elsevier, the leading provider of science and health information.

The training session was conducted online in a hands-on and practical manner to ensure that the programme met all of its objectives.

Provost of UUMKL and Dean of OYAGSB, Prof. Dr. Hassan Abu Bakar stated that the training programme provided a lot of useful input to its postgraduate students.

He expressed hope that the training session would enable all postgraduate students to conduct research in their respective fields in an effective and efficient manner. Furthermore, he stated that OYAGSB intends to hold similar Doctoral trainings in the near future as part of its strategy to broaden the knowledge of postgraduate students.
