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UUM VICE-CHANCELLOR ATTENDS THE ROYAL COMMISSIONING CEREMONY OF ROTU CADET OFFICERS



UUM ONLINE: Selangor, 13 August -- The Vice-Chancellor of UUM, Prof. Dato' Seri Dr. Mohamed Mustafa Ishak, attended the 36th Royal Commissioning Ceremony of Public University ROTU Cadet Officers at the parade ground of Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM) Shah Alam, yesterday.
