REMINDER IN COMPLIANCE TO "ROAD TRAFFIC RULES IN UUM"

KESL ONLINE: Starting next semester the Security Department will enforce the rules regarding vehicle stickers.

Vehicles without stickers will not be allowed to enter the campus. Students caught misusing the stickers, using fake stickers, modifying the stickers, using staff stickers or using unauthorized stickers are subject to disciplinary action in accordance to the university regulations.

This reminder is to inform all students not to bring their own vehicles to the university before getting the vehicle stickers next semester, vehicles without any valid stickers will not be allowed to enter and will have to be parked outside the campus. The

Security Department will not be responsible for any vehicle parked outside the campus.

Operations had been carried out together with DPP management and students had been advised not to use vehicles with unauthorized stickers. Nonetheless, there are still vehicles in the campus without unauthorized stickers.

All students are required to comply with the university's regulations regarding vehicle usage in the campus.
