KEHADIRAN BERTUGAS STAF UUM BERIKUTAN KEADAAN JEREBU YANG MELANDA NEGARA PADA KETIKA INI

Sebagaimana yang Y.Bhg. Dato' /Y. Berusaha Prof./tuan/puan sedia maklum, negara kini berada dalam keadaan musibah akibat masalah jerebu yang melanda. Keadaan berjerebu ini agak membimbangkan dan boleh membahayakan kesihatan terutamanya bagi golongan yang berisiko tinggi termasuk kanak-kanak, orang tua, mereka yang mempunyai penyakit berkaitan pernafasan atau jantung serta mereka yang sentiasa bekerja di luar pejabat atau rumah.

Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia (KKM) menasihatkan orang ramai supaya peka dengan tahap kualiti udara di kawasan masing-masing dan mengambil langkah pencegahan bagi mengurangkan kesan ke atas kesihatan seperti mengurangkan aktiviti luar, memakai topeng muka dan minum air secukupnya.

Buat masa ini, kampus UUM masih beroperasi seperti biasa dan semua staf dikehendaki hadir bertugas pada waktu bekerja. Sebarang pemakluman mengenai penutupan operasi kampus akan dimaklumkan dengan kadar segera seandainya bacaan IPU di kawasan kampus mencapai tahap sangat merbahaya.
