By emulating the praiseworthy traits possessed by the Prophet namely forgiving, non-vindictive, not insulting others, respecting the elderly and being affectionate towards the young and children would indeed lead to a more peaceful and harmonious life.

According to Ustaz Wadi Annuar Ayub, it was recorded in an account, while the Prophet was walking with his companions, a Jew caught hold of the Prophet by his neck and confronted him with harsh and abusive words which angered Umar who retaliated by slapping the hands of the Jewish man.

"But the Prophet forbade Umar and called on him to release the Jew although he was innocent. This action later appealed to the Jew who ultimately pronounced the syahadah.

"The virtue of the Messenger of Allah, too was incomprehensible to Umar, hence crying, Umar acclaimed the great Prophet's praiseworthy morals," he said at a special ceremony celebrating the Birth Anniversary of Prophet Muhammad PBUH (2017/1439H) UUM level, themed "Unity of the Ummah Brings Prosperity to the Nation", held at the Mu'adzam Shah Hall yesterday.

According to Ustaz Wadi Annuar Ayub, the Prophet was sent to refine noble character, the forgiving trait of the final Islamic prophet and messenger of Allah exceeded the nature of his wrath, repaying evil with goodness.

He urged Muslims to keep in mind the greatness of the Prophet's patience and perseverance. He said when the Prophet called upon people of Mecca to the path of Allah, at that time many of them chose the path against the path of Allah. Furthermore, the Prophet was bombarded with both verbal and physical cruelty that hurt him.

"We need to emulate the traits of the Prophet because with his intermediaries, we learn more about Allah and become noble, therefore educate the children to love the Messenger of Allah," he said at the ceremony that resonated with the dzikir and salawat. He also applauded the noble efforts carried out by the Management of the University who were in support of such activities.

Meanwhile, UUM Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Dato' Seri Dr. Mohamed Mustafa Ishak called on all campus denizens to internalise the Prophet's life history, the struggles of the Prophet and also to emulate his morals.

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
