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Forero, C.F. Finch and T. Hill (2003), sports injuries are an important public health issue and a key reason for non-participation in physical activity internationally and in Australia. Sports

injuries are a significant cost burden for injured athletes. In some cases, one in 17 Australians experience sports injuries. The cost of those injuries have been estimated at \$1.5 billion (G, 1991). It also has been estimated that 70% of all level sports in Australia sustain one or more injuries.

Injuries occur during competition / matches. Athletes do not report injury risk during training. Between 10% and 39% (various competition levels of soccer) of injuries may occur during matches / competition. The standard of competition, and the degree of injury risk, is a function of the level of competition.
