Pemilihan Lagu Kebangsaan Persekutuan Tanah Melayu
The National Anthem Selection Federation of Malaya



Lagu 'Negaraku' Lagu Kebangsaan Persekutuan Tanah Melayu Merdeka mula diperdengarkan kepada orang ramai pada malam 31 Ogos 1957, di Padang Kelab Selangor.

"Negaraku" – The Independent Federation of Malaya song began to be played for the public on the night of 31 August 1957 at the Selangor Royal Club field.

Upacara Pemilihan Lagu Kebangsaan bagi Persekutuan Tanah Melayu yang merdeka telah diadakan pada 5 Ogos 1957 bertempat di Dewan Polis Depoh, Kuala Lumpur. Pemilihan ini dibuat oleh Jawatankuasa Pemilihan Lagu Kebangsaan yang dipengerusikan oleh YTM Tunku Abdul Rahman Putra, Ketua Menteri Persekutuan Tanah Melayu dengan ahli-ahlinya terdiri daripada Encik Ya'acob Abdul Latiff (Pengarah Jabatan Penerangan), Tuan A.T. Reid (Timbalan Pengarah Broadcasting), Tuan Ong Yoke Lin (Menteri Kenderaan dan Pengangkutan), Haji Mustapha Al-Bakri (Penyimpan Mohor Besar Raja-raja Melayu), Cik Halimathon, (Ahli Majlis Undangan Persekutuan), Dato' Abdul Razak Hussein (Menteri Pelajaran) dan Tuan W. Crops (Pengarah Muzik, Pasukan Pancaragam Polis Persekutuan). Sebanyak empat buah lagu telah diperdengarkan oleh Pasukan Pancaragam Polis Persekutuan Tanah Melayu. Lagu 'Terang Bulan' lagu kebangsaan negeri Perak dipilih sebagai lagu kebangsaan Persekutuan Tanah Melayu kerana mempunyai unsur-unsur kemelayuan.

Keputusan pemilihan ini kemudiannya dikemukakan untuk diperkenankan oleh Majlis Raja-raja Melayu. Lagu kebangsaan buat pertama kalinya diperdengarkan kepada khayalak ramai pada malam 31 Ogos 1957 di Padang Kelab Selangor.

The National Anthem of the Federation of Malaya Selection Ceremony was held on 5 August 1957 at the Police Depot Hall, Kuala Lumpur. This selection was made by the National Anthem Selection Committee, chaired by YTM Tunku Abdul Rahman Putra, Chief Minister of the Federal of Malaya with the members of Association consisting of Encik Ya'acob Abdul Latiff (Director of Information Services), Tuan A.T. Reid (Deputy Director of Broadcasting), Tuan Ong Yoke Lin (Minister of Vehicle and Transportation), Haji Mustapha Al-Bakri (Keeper of the Malay Rulers' Seal), Cik Halimathon (Member of Federal Legislative Council), Dato' Abdul Razak Hussein (Minister of Education) and Tuan W. Crops (Music Director, Federal Police Force Band). A total of four songs were played by the Federation of Malaya Police Force Band. The song "Terang Bulan" which was the state anthem of Perak was chosen as the Federation of Malaya national anthem due to its Malay elements. The result of this selection was then forwarded to obtain permission from the Council of Malay Rules. The national anthem was first played for the public on the night of 31 August 1957 at the Selangor Royal Club field.
