ICEGE 2018 PROMOTES TRANSNATIONAL COOPERATION IN RESEARCH AND PUBLICATION

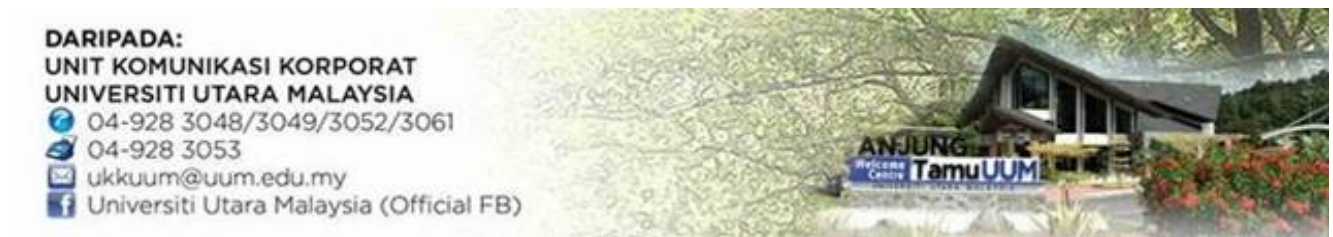
