**URGENT TRAVEL NOTICE ADVICE FOR UUM INTERNATIONAL
STUDENTS FROM CHINA:
NOVEL CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK**

The University takes cognizant of the recent outbreak of the novel coronavirus that is affecting many countries, particularly in China.

Please take note that the period of registration for new students are from 2 to 4 February 2020 and returning students are from 8 to 16 February 2020.

Since the 2nd Semester for the Academic Year 2019/2020 is about to commence, kindly give serious attention to the following precautionary measures:

1. If you are arriving to Malaysia via the Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) or other local airports, please adhere strictly to the rules and regulations imposed by the airport authority and the Malaysian Health Ministry:
 - a) Upon disembarking at KLIA, please make your way to the **HEALTH QUARANTINE CENTRE** located at **LEVEL 3 of the main terminal**, before proceeding to the Immigration counter and the EMGS International Student Arrival Centre (ISAC).
 - b) **Duly inform CIAC (Centre for International Affairs and Cooperation) UUM of your arrivals, travel plans and accommodation.**
2. Within the period of 14 days of entry into the country and you are not at UUM, in the event you experience any **symptoms of sickness (fever/cough/difficulty in breathing)**, immediately visit the nearest health centre/clinic for medical advice and immediately inform UUM Health Centre (PKU)/CIAC.
3. If your arrival to UUM is within 14 days after entry into Malaysia, you will undergo **daily home surveillance** in a designated place on campus (separate hostel/INASIS), during which you will be exempted from attending any classes/lectures. Daily home surveillance is a health monitoring process that will be done by UUM Health Centre (PKU).

Upon arrival at UUM Sintok campus, a security officer will accompany you to UUM Health Centre (PKU) for a full screening / medical checkup.

4. If you decide to **defer** your study for the semester, no academic fees will be levied and the deferment study term will not be considered as part of your study period.
