**UUM CARES: POSTPONEMENT OF PHYSICAL REGISTRATION OF STUDENTS
TO UUM CAMPUS FOR OCTOBER 2020 ADMISSION**

Universiti Utara Malaysia (UUM) has taken the necessary precautions to postpone the physical registration of new and returning students to UUM campus as announced on 15 September 2020 following the increase in number of cases of COVID-19 outbreak in the country.

UUM takes heed of the media statement made by the Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE) dated 2 October 2020 on the Postponement of Physical / Face-to-Face Registration of all students of Higher Institution of Learning for the October 2020 Admission and has agreed to postpone the registration of student admission until a new date that will be announced later.

This decision is based on the current development of COVID-19 pandemic in the country. Nonetheless, student registration will still be implemented but it will be carried out online. Similarly, both teaching and learning activities will also be conducted remotely until a new announcement is made about it.

The measures taken are to ensure the health, safety and well-being of the students of this university are preserved.

UUM has taken proactive steps since February by announcing the measures taken to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic through means of implementing remote teaching and learning modes.

For students who are currently on campus and are pursuing academic activities, they can continue to stay on campus and the university will provide assistance in any way possible to ensure the needs of the students are met.

The Student Orientation Week (SOW) for new students on 7 and 8 October 2020 will continue as scheduled online.

The Teaching and Learning Sessions (TnL) will also proceed according to the schedule carried out remotely from 11 October 2020.

The University will adhere to each and every Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) set by the National Security Council (MKN), Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH) and

MOHE (Ministry of Higher Education) to prevent the spread of this pandemic and to ensure that the UUM campus remains safe.
