The University of Hassan II De Casablanca was represented by its President, Prof. Idriss Mansouri, who signed the MoU on its behalf. The signing was witnessed by Dato' Jamal Hassan, the Malaysian Ambassador to Morocco.

The MoU is aimed at fostering collaborative engagement between the two institutions in a range of areas, specifically Islamic Banking and Finance and the concerns of the World Association of Business Schools in Islamic Countries (WABIS), as well as research and student exchange programmes.
