SYNOPSIS :

Teaching is a form of inquiry, which can be made accountable through a series of reflective practice, self-evaluation, peer review, research and publication. It involves inquiring into one's own teaching practice through a search of critical issues of their interest, and subsequent intervention to improve the situation. Such inquiry can be carried out via the upkeep of a teaching portfolio, and reflection in cyclical processes which involves planning, acting, evaluating and reflecting. This workshop will introduce the fundamentals of Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (SoTL) within the context of higher education. The workshop incorporates interactive lectures and individual/group activities that optimise your teaching experiences in becoming SoTL researchers. Throughout the workshop, you are encouraged to critically reflect on your teaching practice and to bring this personal element into the discussions. Such reflective practice will assist you in gaining an in-depth understanding of SoTL research approaches of inquiry.
