### **Prof Kamarulnizam: Regional Cooperation is an Essential Part in Counter Terrorism**

Recent terror attacks in Marawi and Barcelona purportedly staged by the Daesh have impacted international peace and security. International community, especially major powers, has been seen to be unable to find the right strategies and formulas to overcome it. Therefore, according to Prof. Kamarulnizam Abdullah, Dean of Ghazali Shafie Graduate School of Government, and concurrently the Director of UUM Research Institute for Indonesia, Thailand, and Singapore (UUM-ITS), regional cooperation is the best approach to mitigate the threats. Bilateral intelligent sharing needs to be strengthened. He further elaborated that ASEAN already has many regional counter-terrorism protocols that deal with counter-terrorism especially on information and intelligent sharing, capacity building, and strategic trainings. He said this in the question and answer session at the Seoul Defence Dialogue 2017 (SDD 2017) in South Korea recently. Prof. Kamarulnizam was one of the key invited speakers in the fourth session on “The New Forms of Terrorism and Global Coordination on Counter-terrorism”.

The Dialogue was attended by more than 200 participants from 51 countries including representatives from international organizations such as the United Nations and NATO. The SDD 2017, which is its fifth year, was organized by the South Korea’s National Defence Ministry with a theme- “Visions for Security Cooperation in an Age of Uncertainty.”
