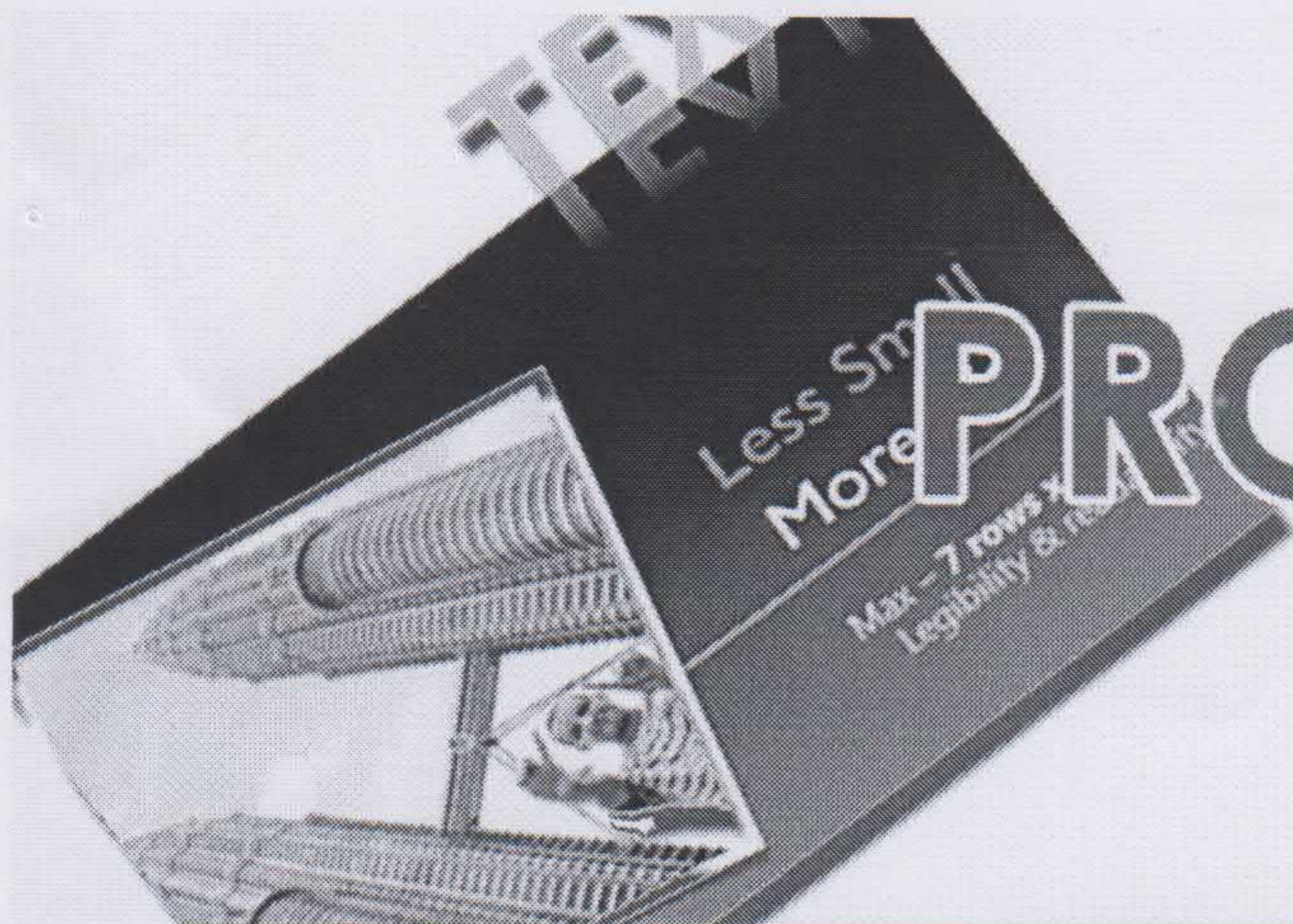

SYNOPSIS

The course intent is to enhance skills in preparing slides (MS PowerPoint) for presentation, using

1. Interaction design theory – emphasizing on the look and feel in terms of colours, layout, contrast, fonts, and styles.
2. Determined concepts (minimalist, contemporary, modern,...)

The aims of the workshop is to help participants in preparing professional slides which are effective and easier to understand without having to read small texts, understanding complex graphics or harebrained animation.
