Pada 3 Jun 1957, satu perhimpunan menyambut ketibaan Rombongan Kemerdekaan ke London yang merundingkan hal berkaitan dengan Rangka Perlembagaan Persekutuan Tanah Melayu telah diadakan di Lapangan Terbang Tentera Udara, Sungai Besi, Kuala Lumpur. Lebih dua ribu orang telah berkumpul bagi menyambut kepulangan seramai tujuh orang anggota rombongan yang diketuai oleh YTM Tunku Abdul Rahman Putra, Ketua Menteri Persekutuan Tanah Melayu. Anggota rombongan ini terdiri daripada tiga orang wakil daripada pihak kerajaan dan tiga lagi wakil daripada Raja-raja Melayu. Antara yang turut serta dalam rundingan yang berlangsung selama lapan hari di Pejabat Tanah Jajahan Inggeris di London ini ialah Encik Ong Yoke Lin, Encik V.T Sambanthan, Encik Mohamed Khir Johari dan Penyimpan Mohor Besar Raja-raja, Tuan Haji Mustapha Al-Bakri. Hasil rundingan yang diadakan ini satu persetujuan telah dicapai dan membawa kepada pembentukan Perlembagaan Persekutuan Tanah Melayu 1957.

On 3 June, 1957, a rally welcoming the independence delegation to London to negotiate independence with regards to the Framework of the Federation of Malaya was held at the Air Force Airport, Sungai Besi, Kuala Lumpur. Over two thousand people gathered to celebrate the return of the seven members of the delegation led by Tunku Abdul Rahman Putra, the Chief Minister of the Malay Federation. Members of this group comprised three representatives from the government and three other representatives of the Malay Rulers. Among those who participated in negotiations that lasted for eight days at the British Colonial Office in London were Mr. Ong Yoke Lin, Mr. V.T Sambanthan, Encik Mohamed Khir Johari and the Keeper of the Rulers' Seal, Tuan Haji Mustapha Al-Bakri. As a result of this negotiation, an agreement was reached which led to the formation of the Federation of Malaya in 1957.
