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UUM-MIMOS BERHAD PACT SET TO AFFORD THE STATE OF KEDAH WITH OPPORTUNITIES IN ICT



UUM ONLINE: Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Ahmad Bashawir Abdul Ghani received a courtesy call from the delegates of MIMOS Berhad headed by Chief Executive Officer, Mr. Ahmad Rizan Ibrahim and five senior officials of MIMOS yesterday.

This follow-up visit was aimed at discussing possible research collaborations by means of assisting the Kedah State Government create opportunities in terms of Information Communication Technology (ICT) and bring its ICT level to a higher level.

In addition to meeting with the Vice-Chancellor, UUM researchers also conducted demonstration of research projects which involved Data analytics, Internet of Things (IoT), Augmented Reality / Virtual Reality and Sintok Board for Dyslexia Children at the Chancellery Meeting Room.

The discussion involved the Dean of the School of Computing (SoC), Prof. Dr. Huda Ibrahim; Director of the Institute for Advanced and Smart Digital Opportunities (IASDO), Assoc. Prof. Dr. Azizah Ahmad and Director of the Centre for University-Industry Collaboration (CUIC), Assoc. Prof. Dr. Mohd Sobri Don.

At the end of the discussion, both parties agreed to carry out projects related to science data, smart agriculture, Augmented Reality / Virtual Reality for Old Kedah, flood management and Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) programmes for school leavers.

Both parties also agreed to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in the near future.

Mr. Ahmad Rizan said that UUM was chosen because of its expertise and its trained academic staff who are able to implement the collaborative programme.

Also present at the discussion were the Dean of the School of Creative Industry Management and Performing Arts (SCIMPA), Dr Ahmad Hisham Zainal Abidin; and other involved researchers.



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
