The talk, which entitled, "Getting to Know Your PhD Policies and Procedures" was given by Dr Nazlina Zakaria who is the Management Postgraduate Coordinator for SBM.

The two-hour session ended on a very fruitful as participants were actively involved in the Q&A sessions and Dr. Nazlina in return has managed to clarify the important issues that have been highlighted by students.
