UUM ONLINE: Alor Setar – The Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Ahmad Bashawir Abdul Ghani was granted an audience with Yang Teramat Mulia Dato' Seri Diraja Tan Sri Tunku Puteri Intan Safinaz Binti Almarhum Sultan Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah, Tunku Temenggong of Kedah who is also the Pro-Chancellor of UUM at the Keriang Hill Resort recently.

The audience was aimed at extending a royal invitation to the Yang Teramat Mulia Tunku Pro-Chancellor to preside over the first session of the 32nd UUM Convocation Ceremony and present scrolls to the graduates of the Tunku Puteri Intan Safinaz (TISSA-UUM) at a session which will be decided on later.
