UUM ONLINE: As a means to promote unity among members of staff, alumni and local communities, Universiti Utara Malaysia (UUM) has launched a number of initiatives in areas concerning management in its efforts to improve the university's administration and financial management.

UUM Vice-Chancellor, Prof Dato' Dr Ahmad Bashawir Abdul Ghani said the initiatives planned by UUM's top management were to ensure that UUM can achieve continuous well-being, prosperity and excellence.

He said amongst the initiatives were the implementation of the waqf fund collection through the establishment of the UUM Waqf Fund Scheme and the Pre-Launch of the UUM Vehicle Registration Number.

He said that UUM had been entrusted by the Kedah State Islamic Religious Council (MAIK) to carry out the collection of waqf fund starting from September and with that UUM agreed to set up the UUM Cash Waqf and Endowment Fund to enable contributions made by contributors were received and managed in stages.

"Through this scheme, UUM was given the approval to raise funds for UUM and to administer the funds for the purpose of spirituality, welfare, education, health and the interests of the university community.

"Every donation received will be channelled to MAIK and the money will be made into a fixed deposit or asset purchase which will be monitored by a joint committee comprising UUM and MAIK members. Hence forth, the proceeds will be channelled back to UUM to be used for the purpose of education and human capital development," he said at the UUM Staff Monthly Assembly at the Perdana Square recently.

At the same event, the Vice-Chancellor also officiated the pre-launch of UUM Vehicle Registration Number. The recent initiative which received approval from the Ministry of Education Malaysia and the Road Transport Department was aimed at selling special vehicle registration number bearing the University's initial.

The Vice-Chancellor said the purpose of the initiative was to enable members of staff to show their spirit of togetherness and love for the University. Hence, as a means of expressing their love for the University, UUM staff were invited to place their bookings for their preferred vehicle registration number through the portal which will be announced later. This initiative would definitely generate income for UUM.

He also expressed hope that the UUM denizens could share the pleasures bequeathed by God through donations made to the UUM Waqf and Endowment Fund and also place bookings for the vehicle registration number bearing the UUM prefix as a way of expressing their spirit of togetherness and 'Love our UUM'.



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
