UUM SUCCESSFULLY ATTAINS ITS MS ISO 9001:2015 RE-CERTIFICATION



UUM ONLINE: SIRIM QAS Chief Auditor, Mdm. Hanida Ghazali presented the report findings of the audit of the respective departments at a special meeting that signalled the conclusion of the SIRIM QAS MS ISO 9001: 2015 Re-certification Audit and the MS ISO 9001: 2015 Surveillance Audit (OYAGSB) held at the Senate Meeting Room, recently.

The SIRIM auditors were also satisfied with the surveillance audit at OYAGSB and graciously informed that the OYAGSB certification will be included in the UUM certification by the year 2020. The scope of OYAGSB will be included in the UUM scope in addition to the GSGSG and AHS GS.
