CITE YOUR PAST WORK

Cite your past work when it is relevant to a new manuscript. Then, it also allow user to facilitate accessing the reference.

CAREFULLY CHOOSE YOUR KEYWORDS

Choose the correct keywords that can make the user feel easy to do searching.

3

USE CONSISTENT FORM

Use a consistent form of your name on all papers. Using the same name will make it easier for others to find all of your published works. For example:
Author's name is Amira Ali, so she always use 'AA' to represent her name on their published works.

USE KEYWORDS & PHRASES

Use the keywords and phrases in your title. If a title have a keywords, the possibility for accessing the published work is high.

MAKE SURE THAT INFORMATION IS CORRECT

Check that your name and affiliation are correct at manuscript. Then, check also the paper's information is accurate in database searches.

6

USE SOCIAL MEDIA

Provide links to your papers on social media. For example, Facebook, Twitter, ResearchGate and Mendeley.
