Grounded theory (GT) is a useful framework for guiding a particularly effective qualitative approach to exploratory research. The aim of this workshop is to provide participants with the knowledge, conceptions and practical perspectives of conducting research within social science settings using the grounded theory research design. In this workshop, GT as a research methodology will be explored with a practical approach and with the aim of giving answer to questions such as "what is grounded theory", "how to do research using grounded theory", "how to collect data".

Additionally, a number of activities will be presented to provide participants with a sample of the process and activities involved in using the GT research design.

Open discussion will occur for general questions that arise.
