Professor Dr is the first person in ASIA and the world during the 1990s, to have obtained two (2) postgraduate degrees in Risk Management; MSc in Risk Management and Insurance from Golden Gate University (GGU), San Francisco, California, USA; and PhD in Risk Management from Glasgow Caledonian University (GCU), Glasgow, Scotland, UK. He is the President of the International Institute of Risk Management and Crisis Strategies (IIRMACS); World Muslims Risk Management Think-Tank Network (WMRMTTN); Malaysia Muslims Risk Management Think-Tank Network (MMRMTTN); Malaysian Risk Management Think-Tank Network (MRMTTN) and Malaysian Group of Scholars and Thinkers on Risk Management (MGSTRIM). Importantly, Prof Dr Rasid is also a member of the World Expert Group (WEG) for Risk Management Standard and sits in the ISO Technical Committee (ISO/TC-262- Risk Management). He has conducted a lot of training, workshops, seminars and conferences all over the world.
