UUM ONLINE: A total of 100 officers from various public universities all over the country attended the Ministry of Higher Education Development Action Committee (MoHE DAC) meeting at the EDC Hotels & Resorts yesterday.

The meeting which was chaired by the Deputy Chief Secretary (Development) Dato' Nik Ali Mat Yunus, was also attended by the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Dato' Seri Dr. Mohamed Mustafa Ishak.
